

**Minutes of the meeting of  
Hulcott Parish Council held on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2018, 7.30pm at All Saints Church, Hulcott**

Present: Councillors Peter Fenton O’Creedy (Chairman), Bruce Lewington, Bob Masini, Ian Pleeth, Deborah Roberts, Ruth Powell (Clerk)

- 1/93 Apologies for absence were received and accepted from Councillor Green.
- 2/93 No interests were declared on agenda items.
- 3/93 The minutes of the meetings on 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2018 and 18<sup>th</sup> June 2018 were agreed as a true record and signed by the Chairman.
- 4/93 Matters arising from the minutes:  
6/91 It had been suggested that the new noticeboard in Rowsham Road could be headed with *Hulcott Parish Council* and Councillors Fenton O’Creedy and Pleeth will look into this.  
3/92 The repairs to the village roads had been completed and the first payment made to the contractor. However some surface cracks had since appeared and the contractor has been asked to deal with these.  
4/92 Enquiries have been made to Bucks County Council about adoption of the newly repaired roads. A response is awaited.
- 5/90 Finance
- Payments and receipts to date were noted and verified with the bank statement.
  - Payment to the clerk was agreed.
  - The internal auditor’s report was noted.
  - It was agreed that the parish council, as a data controller under the 2018 General Data Protection Regulations, will register with the Information Commission’s Office and pay the £40 fee.
- 6/93 Planning
- Since the last meeting the parish council had responded to AVDC on applications:  
18/02026/APP objection to erection of dwelling and associated garage/store outbuilding; with change of use of land to residential amenity at Cane End Farm;  
18/01957/APP objections to variation to approved conditions for the crematorium on grounds of visibility of the flue and replacement of the brick building with shipping container. However parish councillors had since attended a site meeting on 3<sup>rd</sup> August where it was demonstrated that the storage container will be screened. Discussions had also taken place to agree a colour of the chimney flue. It was agreed that the parish council would withdraw its objection to the application.
- 7/93 It was agreed that the revised Standing Orders should be adopted.
- 8/93 Other matters reported
- Councillor Pleeth reported that repairs to the churchyard wall adjoining Manor House were underway and a pile of rubble had been placed on the verge outside the churchyard.
  - No decision of the closure of All Saints Church is expected before the end of 2019.
- 9/93 The next meeting will take place on 8<sup>th</sup> January 2019.
